

GM Is Closing Our Plant

General Motors demolished our Poletown neighborhood—homes, houses of worship, businesses—to build the Detroit/Hamtramck Assembly Center, promising good jobs and a bright future. And for 34 years, our workforce turned out some of the best-built vehicles in the world and made GM billions. Then the company was broke. So you saved them, with the taxpayer federal bailout—about \$11 billion of which GM never paid back. Thanks to your money saving the company, just last year, GM's North American operations had a profit of \$2.8 billion, a 37% increase. But now GM is closing our plant. The result:

- 1,500 jobs lost
- \$850,000 gone annually from the City budget
- \$115,000 gone annually from our schools
- Untold amounts from our community's business

How do we keep the plant open?

If GM continues with its plan to close the plant, what does GM owe our community, our city, our schools, our children?
